2017 Horizon 2020 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Update

Dear Madam or Sir,

€838 million will be available for research and innovation in the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions under Horizon 2020 (European Framework Programme for Research and Innovation) in 2017. In this update, we inform you about the upcoming calls for proposals in the MSCA and about the information and training events we offer. Switzerland is fully associated to H2020 from 1 January 2017 onward and thus there are no restrictions regarding participation for Swiss researchers and institutions for the 2017 calls for proposals.
